Kathleen, age 57, is a former TV producer and professional voice-over talent for the Discovery Channel. In 2007, she was involved in a tractor-trailer accident and later developed severe nerve damage, stenosis and degenerative disc disease. Unfortunately, Kathleen's strong pain medications also caused dental disease and degeneration, requiring treatment far beyond what she could afford on her social security disability payments. Three very generous volunteers in Dental Lifeline Network's Donated Dental Services (DDS) program came to Kathleen's rescue. Dr. Justin Burns, a DDS oral surgeon extracted eight teeth. Dr. Scott Pettinato, a general dentist, fitted Kathleen with an upper 9-unit bridge and a lower 10unit bridge. Fabrications were donated by Joe Bakanawski, owner of DeLux Dental Lab, who also serves on the DLN Pennsylvania Leadership Council. DeLux Dental Lab is one of 162 labs that volunteer for Pennsylvania DDS.

Kathleen is overwhelmed with excitement and gratitude for how these DDS volunteers changed her life.

Dental School Graduates Honored

Dental Lifeline Network partners with dental schools through the Brian D. Stone Memorial Award to recognize graduating students who have committed to volunteerism or to helping people with special needs. In Pennsylvania, two schools of dental medicine presented awards to a graduate. 2015 award recipients were Dr. Matthew Brezinski, University of Pittsburgh School of Dental Medicine, and Dr. David Alexander Klass, Temple University Kornberg School of Dentistry.



Dr. Matthew Brezinski received the 2015 Brian D. Stone Memorial Award from Dr. Lynne M. Taiclet, DMD, Assistant Professor and Director of the Center for Patients with Special Needs at the University of Pittsburgh School of Dental Medicine.

Pennsylvania Donated Dental Services (DDS) is a program of Dental Lifeline Network, a national humanitarian organization providing access to comprehensive dental care for society's most vulnerable people with disabilities or who are elderly or medically fragile and have no other way to get help. Nationally, DDS has more than 15,000 volunteer dentists and 3,700 volunteer laboratories.

Of this amount, 40 patients received \$43,550 in ongoing care from DDS volunteer dentists who provided these patients with initial restorative treatment and have elected to continue providing routine and ongoing care.
