DDS Volunteers Help Fight Diabetes

Dina, age 60, a nurse of 27 vears with diabetes, was forced to retire due to a work-related injury, followed by a wheelchair accident. Restricted to a diet of pureed food and unable to afford dental care, Dina's remaining teeth were painful, frequently abscessed, decayed and broken. Diabetes is one of many lifethreatening medical conditions adversely impacted by dental disease. Dental treatment can prevent further complications that Donated Dental Services (DDS) patients cannot afford medically or financially.Nearly 22 million Americans or 9.3% of the U.S. population had diabetes in 2012, the 7th leading cause of death (National Diabetes Statistics Report, 2014).

DLN Program Highlights

More DDS Patients Receive Treatment

- 2013-2014 Thanks to our generous volunteers and supporters, fiscal year-end figures revealed that nearly 7,700 patients received \$24.8 million in comprehensive donated dental care - an increase of 357 patients treated over the previous year. An additional 6,145 patients are currently in treatment nationwide. (DLN's fiscal year ended June 30, 2014.)
- Vermont. State Dental Society assisted DLN in launching a new Vermont DDS program with funding from Northeast Delta Dental. In the start-up program's first year, seven patients received \$27,645 dollars in treatment and 97 dentists and 10 dental labs volunteered.
- Iowa. DDS will grow in 2014-2015 after Delta Dental of Iowa successfully lobbied the Iowa General Assembly to increase state funding by \$43,043 to \$74,640. DDS Program Coordinator hours are being expanded and additional volunteers recruited to increase the number of patients who can be served.
- More Volunteers. Last year, 626 dentists and nearly 400 labs joined DDS as new volunteers. Nationwide, 15,000 dentists and 4,000 labs volunteer for DDS.
