The Story

Erik, 61, lives in Lisbon and has worked in an auto body shop for most of his life. After being exposed to fumes at the garage for many years, he began having trouble breathing and was diagnosed with COPD. He started wearing a respirator but still could not breathe well and had to stop working. Erik also had oral health issues: missing, decayed teeth and periodontal disease caused him immense pain and discomfort. Unable to work, Erik lived off of savings and other assistance but could not afford the needed dental treatment. He needed help, but had nowhere to turn.

How DDS Helped

Erik was referred to **Donated Dental Services (DDS)** and a team of volunteers agreed to help: Dr. Francis H. Zeck Jr. extracted four teeth and donated a partial lower denture and Precision Dental Laboratory fabricated the partial denture.
