A Message from Our Chairman



This year we celebrate a monumental milestone. *Our Donated Dental Services (DDS) program now has provided over \$250 million in treatment since 1986 to more than 120,000 vulnerable people.* While this achievement is a tribute to the organization, the real credit goes to the 15,000 dentists and 3,600 laboratories that donate their time and skills to help those in need.

Dental Lifeline Network provides a national safety net for people who are elderly, severely ill or have disabilities and lack financial resources. Because Medicare does not cover dental treatment and in most states Medicaid programs do not provide dental care for adults, we are literally the last resort for many who have nowhere else to turn.

In New Jersey, 49-year-old Frankie, who has Down Syndrome, needed restorative work and implants to keep his dentures in place. Frankie lives with and is dependent on his sister, Maria. They could neither afford his dental care, nor rely on public assistance.

Through DDS, Frankie was referred to volunteers Dr. Lisa Ference, who donated Frankie's restorations, and Dr. Glen Gorab, the oral surgeon who placed his implants. Straumann donated eight implants, and Exceledent Lab, Inc., contributed an over denture and four implant attachments.

I saw a story quoting Maria that best expresses how meaningful these services are:

“ Before Frankie's dental treatment, all his food had to be cut into small pieces. Now he can eat anything. Dr. Ference was excellent and her staff was really great. Frankie's always smiling and looking in the mirror. He's very attached to his teeth! ” – Maria, sister and advocate for Frankie

The professionals who volunteer their services through DDS value the opportunity to help. As Frankie's dentist noted:

“ My team enjoys helping and we are very interested in these patients' lives. DDS is a fabulous way to give back. It's great to have an organized way to screen people and guide them to dentists who can help. Seeing their smiles – there's no way to describe it. ” – Lisa Ference, DMD

I am pleased to report that in fiscal year 2013, funds raised to support the organization's services increased by 11 percent to nearly \$5.2 million, including \$1.8 million from gross sales of DentaCheques coupon books.

Although thousands of people have been helped through our programs, tens of thousands of others seek care. This year, Dental Lifeline Network initiated a new strategic plan that we hope will result in involving more dentists and laboratories as volunteers.

We are grateful to our volunteer dentists and laboratories, dental industry partners, funding organizations and donors whose support makes it possible to restore the oral health and quality of life of the thousands of disadvantaged people served over the past year.

On behalf of the Board of Directors and staff of Dental Lifeline Network, we express our sincerest thanks to all who make this important work possible.

Program Highlights

Donated Dental Services (DDS)

- DDS volunteers include more than 15,000 dentists and 3,600 laboratories across 50 states. An additional 276 laboratories volunteered in Fiscal Year 2012-2013.
- Through DDS, 7,337 people received nearly \$23.3 million in donated dental treatment including nearly \$2 million in fabrications donated by laboratories.
- Since 1986, DDS has provided \$250 million in treatment to highly vulnerable people with disabilities or who are elderly or medically fragile. Thousands more contact us each year in urgent need of help.

Dental HouseCalls

- Dental HouseCalls provided \$1,048,721 in treatment to 2,392 people with disabilities or who are elderly and for whom travel to dentists' offices poses a hardship. Dental HouseCalls operates in Colorado and Illinois; in New Jersey, a similar portable treatment program is part of Bridge/Campaign of Concern, helping people with developmental disabilities.

Bridge/Campaign of Concern

- Bridge/Campaign of Concern presented in-service training to 2,741 case managers, residential staff and parents. Those trained directly or indirectly serve 12,008 people with developmental disabilities who cannot care for their own teeth or have difficulty receiving treatment. Bridge/Campaign of Concern operates in New Jersey and Colorado.

American Association of Orthodontists (AAO) Donated Orthodontic Services (DOS) Program

Donated Orthodontic Services (DOS), a program of the AAO in partnership with Dental Lifeline Network, includes 380 volunteer orthodontists and 453 active patients in Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, New Jersey and Rhode Island. DOS enables low-income children to receive free orthodontic treatment.

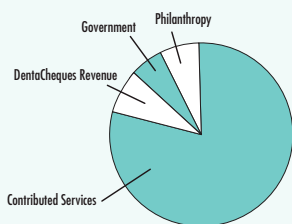

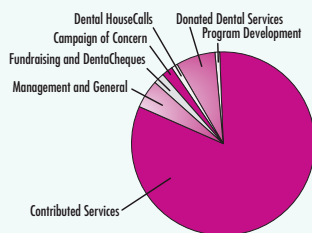

Caroline Montero, a DDS Program Coordinator, referred George to Drs. Jonathan Perry, an oral surgeon, and Martin Schwartz, a general dentist. Dr. Perry extracted several teeth and Dr. Schwartz fitted George with full dentures.

Soon after, with his new smile making and leaving impressions wherever he went, George secured a job as a substance abuse counselor.

Meanwhile, George has renewed confidence and purpose.

Brian D. Stone Memorial Awards

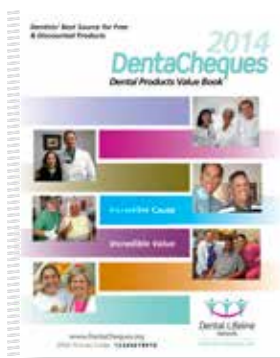


Each year, Dental Lifeline Network recognizes graduating dental school students who have exhibited a proven commitment to community volunteerism or helping people with special needs through the Brian D. Stone Memorial Award program. Dental Lifeline Network works in partnership with dental schools across the country to identify and acknowledge emerging dentists who model the role of volunteerism. The awards program was established by Drs. Joy and Justin Stone of New Jersey.

This year, awards program partners included the University of Illinois at Chicago, College of Dentistry; Southern Illinois University, School of Dental Medicine; Indiana University School of Dentistry; University of Iowa, College of Dentistry; Louisiana State University, School of Dentistry; University of Minnesota School of Dentistry; University of Mississippi Medical Center School of Dentistry, and University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey – New Jersey Dental School.
