

# DENTAL LIFELINE NETWORK OREGON

More than Dentistry. Life.

Chaya, age 40, was diagnosed many years ago with progressive Multiple Sclerosis. A single mother of two children, she also had severe dental disease. Chaya depends on social security disability insurance and child support to raise her family, and had no way to pay for the dental treatment she badly needed. A team of Donated Dental Services (DDS) volunteers transformed Chaya's life. Dr. Normund Auzins, an oral surgeon, performed a full mouth extraction and an alveoplasty and Dr. Reed Hall, a general dentist, fitted Chaya with full upper and lower dentures, fabricated by Custom Dental Prosthetics, one of 113 dental laboratories that volunteer for Oregon DDS. Chaya is able to chew real food again and very proud of her new smile.
