Clyde, age 65 is a United States Armed Services Veteran living in Rawlins and suffers from hearing loss and heart problems, including irregular heartbeat. He lives with his wife and survives on a limited Social Security income. Clyde's teeth were in poor condition and needed extracted before he could have his heart condition addressed. He was unable to afford the dental care he desperately needed. Donated Dental Services (DDS) came to Clyde's rescue and provided him with the dental treatment he needed. Dr. Jim Engstrom, general dentist and DDS volunteer along with volunteer oral surgeon Dr. Nathan Steele performed extractions to restore Clyde's oral health. Volunteer lab, Master Craft Dental Laboratory of Colorado, donated full upper and a lower partial for Clvde.
