The Story

Suzan, 65, lives alone in Westerly and has multiple sclerosis and osteoporosis. After working as a bookkeeper and secretary most of her life she went back to school to become a dental assistant, but her health problems prevented her from pursuing her career. She had a salivary gland infection that required surgery and then a stay at a rehabilitation facility, where she developed pneumonia and fell and broke her arm. Upon returning home, her oral health began to deteriorate: three teeth broke and fell out within a few months, making eating difficult and causing constant pain. She survives on a Social Security Disability benefit and the dental care she needed was out of her financial reach.

How DDS Helped

Wood River Health Services referred Suzan to **Donated Dental Services (DDS)** and a team of volunteers agreed to help: oral surgeon Dr. Dante Gulino extracted 11 teeth, general dentist and board member Dr. Jennifer Torbett restored 12 more, and Guthrie Dental Kinetics fabricated the dentures.
