The Story

Maunteel, 94, is a widower who lives with her daughter in New Augusta. She helps care for her daughter, who has battled cancer twice and continues to experience health problems. Though Maunteel's mental and physical health are stable, her oral health needed attention. Her 20-yearold dentures no longer fit, making it difficult to eat. Not being able to eat properly caused Maunteel to lose a lot of weight over the past several years. Though she has Medicaid and Medicare benefits, they do not cover the new dentures she needed.

How DDS Helped

A Medicaid representative referred her to the **Donated Dental Services (DDS)** program and a team of volunteers came to her aid:

- Oral surgeon Dr. Curtis Bishop removed some of her jaw bone. Dr. Zachariah Crawford restored three teeth and donated new full upper and lower dentures and an adjustment.
- Blackburn Dental Lab, Inc. fabricated the dentures.
