

# Dental Lifeline Network • New Hampshire July 2015–June 2016 Annual Report

## The Story

Philip, 52, lives in Northern New Hampshire and once worked for a business detailing cars, snowmobiles, and motorcycles, and assisting mechanics with repair work. In 2007 he was struck by a car while walking and remained in a coma for over a year. Now he has significant brain damage, short-term memory loss, seizures, and chronic pain. Consequently, because of his disability, Philip has not been able to work or take care of his teeth. As a result, his oral health deteriorated over time. He needed extensive dental care, but could not afford the treatment.

## How DDS Helped

Philip had been a longtime patient of Dr. Charles Schmidt, a **Donated Dental Services (DDS)** volunteer. Dr. Schmidt referred Philip to the program, where he was linked with two additional generous volunteers.

- Dr. Charles Schmidt fitted him with a full set of dentures.
- Oral surgeon Dr. Dennis Hannon performed full mouth extractions.
- DOS Dental Lab, LLC fabricated a new set of upper and lower dentures.
