The Story

Richard, 69, lives alone in central Mississippi. He enjoys getting out in his community and visits with his sister and friends regularly. Richard worked in production plants and lumber companies before experiencing a terrible motorcycle accident. The pain in his left ankle never fully healed and he had to have his leg amputated below the knee. Richard now has a prosthetic leg and uses a walker.

Unfortunately, Richard also had poor oral health. He was missing many of his teeth and had not seen a dentist in several years. Due to heart problems, his physician urged him to immediately see a dentist. Richard survives on a small Social Security benefit and his disability insurance did not cover the cost of the dental treatment he desperately needed. He seemed to have nowhere to turn for help.

How DDS Helped

He was referred to the **Donated Dental Services (DDS)** program and received the following help:

- · Dr. W. Mark Donald performed multiple extractions, donated and placed implants, and donated full upper and lower dentures.
- Triangle Dental Laboratory fabricated the dentures.
