The Story

Gregory, 66, is a dedicated family man who lives in Saint Paul and has multiple sclerosis, osteoarthritis, and congestive heart failure. He endures periods of excruciating pain and often has difficulty getting around without the use of a cane.

Unfortunately, the many medications Gregory was prescribed to treat his medical conditions caused a significant decline in his oral health. Several of his teeth were broken and infected and he found it very hard and painful to eat. He tried to use an old set of dentures that did not fit properly but that only caused more pain. Gregory survives on a modest Social Security disability benefit and small pension and could not afford the extensive dental treatment he needed. It seemed as though he had nowhere to turn for help.
