The Story

Laura, 48, lives in Sarasota and is fighting Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia. After undergoing several rounds of chemotherapy, a stem cell transplant was Laura's last treatment option. To qualify for a transplant she first needed dental clearance. Laura hadn't been to a dentist in a few years and often experienced pain when eating. Before her diagnosis, Laura enjoyed working, and spending time with her friends. She liked to entertain her friends and family with stories of life growing up around the Ringling Brothers Circus where her parents were performers. Now her focus is getting healthy again.

With only a small Social Security Disability benefit and food stamps, Laura's monthly expenses exceed her income and she has difficulty making ends meet. Unfortunately, she could not afford the dental treatment she needed in order to qualify for the transplant. It seemed she had nowhere to turn for help.


How DDS Helped
