The Story

Susan, 59, lives in Louisville and enjoys cooking, baking, and doing crafts. She has a number of health challenges including fibromyalgia, Behcet's (an auto-immune inflammatory disorder), and mental health issues. Susan worked for many years as a medical assistant but her poor health now prevents her from working.

Sadly, Susan's dental health was also in bad shape. She was missing many of her teeth and those that remained were loose and decayed. Her primary care physician urged her to address these issues before they impacted her overall health. Susan survives on a small Social Security benefit and has difficulty making ends meet. Unfortunately, she could not afford the dental treatment she needed. It seemed she had nowhere to turn for help.

How DDS Helped

Susan was referred to the **Donated Dental** Services (DDS) program and was linked with three generous volunteers:

- · Dr. Joseph W. Jacobi donated full upper and lower dentures.
- · Oral Surgeon Dr. David Naselsker performed multiple extractions and a jaw smoothing procedure.
- · Affinity Dental Lab fabricated the dentures at no cost.

Post Treatment

Thanks to this team, Susan was able to receive the gift of dentures just in time for the holidays. Susan's health has significantly improved and she can now eat properly again.
