Darren, 54, lives in Santa Rosa County with his sister. He was a nurse in an emergency room for many years and truly enjoyed helping people. Darren also enjoyed coaching soccer. Due to health issues, he is no longer able to work or coach and misses both. Now, he enjoys spending time with his daughter and six grandchildren when he can.

Darren had surgery on his left ankle due to an injury and now has to use a cane or walker to get around. He also has high blood pressure and other health issues. Unfortunately, Darren's dental health also needed attention. He was missing several teeth and those that remained had become infected. In addition, his flex upper partial denture was broken and didn't fit properly.

Sadly, Darren was unable to afford treatment to address his dental needs. Darren applied for Social Security Disability and is awaiting the results. With no income, the dental treatment Darren needed seemed like a luxury beyond his reach.


