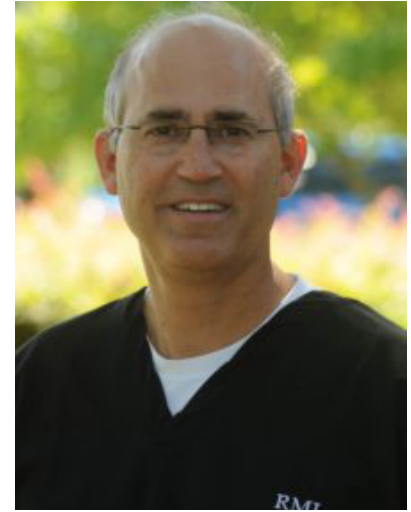


THE STORY

Dean, 71, lives with his wife in Kershaw County. Prior to his retirement, he owned a furniture store. His wife recently lost her job as an interior designer due to the COVID-19 pandemic. He suffers from stage 5 Chronic Kidney Disease (CKD) and receives dialysis at home.

Unfortunately, Dean's dental health was another challenge. He was missing several teeth and others were broken and decayed. Both a crown and a filling had fallen out and another crown had become abscessed. Dean was in extreme pain and desperately needed help.

No longer able to work, Dean and his wife survive on limited Social Security benefits. Their monthly expenses exceed their income and they struggle to make ends meet. He could not afford the needed dental treatment.

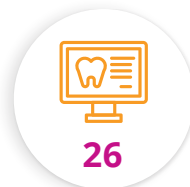

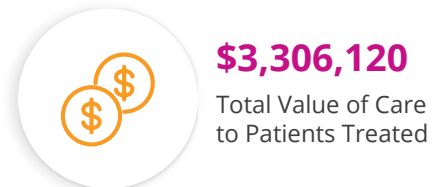
