





Many people with disabilities or who are elderly or medically fragile cannot afford dental care. Sadly, many of these are military veterans who once served our country, but now don't have access to dental treatment.

Because of Congressional limitations, the Veterans Administration only provides dental treatment to a small fraction of veterans, leaving many without the care they need.

For more than 40 years, Dental Lifeline Network has been a national leader in helping people access the dental care they cannot afford. With this long history of service, we now seek to change the lives of our nation's veterans with the Lifeline Heroes Challenge.







Lee, 65, is an Army and Air Force veteran who lives in Connecticut. He suffers from heart problems and has had coronary stents placed.

His dental health was another challenge: he was missing many teeth and others were decayed and broken. Lee had exposed roots that caused pain when he ate. His mouth was swollen and he was in pain, but sadly, he could not afford the treatment he needed to address his deteriorating dental health.

Surviving on only a Social Security benefit and small pension, Lee struggles to make ends meet. Since his dental problems were not service related, he could not access treatment through the VA. It seemed the care he desperately needed was far beyond his reach.

Fortunately, the DDS program was able to help and two generous volunteers came to Lee's aid. An oral surgeon extracted 11 teeth and a general dentist, with help from a volunteer laboratory, donated a full upper denture and partial lower denture. Thanks to these caring volunteers, Lee received \$8,150 in donated treatment that restored his dental health and gave him a new reason to smile.
