THE STORY

Peter, a 76-year-old Army veteran, lives with his wife in Cook County. He worked for a company that financed farm equipment for many years until his retirement. Peter was drafted during the Vietnam War and served 2.5 years overseas. During his service he was exposed to Agent Orange, a chemical herbicide used during the Vietnam War, which left Peter and many other veterans with disabilities. He also suffers from heart disease and type II diabetes.

In addition to these health concerns, Peter's dental health was also deteriorating. During his service, he sustained an injury to his face and lost his front teeth. More recently, he had several broken and missing teeth and was not able to afford the dental treatment he needed.

HOW DDS HELPED

Fortunately, Peter applied to the **Donated Dental** Services (DDS) program and was linked with generous volunteers who restored his health.

Who Helped: Dr. David Haugen, a military veteran himself, who enjoys helping fellow veterans in need, and Dr. Duncan Puffer, an oral surgeon, extracted nine teeth and alveoplasty. Udell Dental Lab generously donated full upper and lower dentures at no cost.
