THE STORY

The Dental Lifeline Network • Florida program helps patients like Wilton, 74, who lives with his wife, daughter, and grandson in Marion County. A veteran, Wilton served in the U.S. Army and Army National Guard for 36 years before retiring. During his military career, Wilton was deployed to Afghanistan, and now suffers from PTSD related to his deployment. Additionally, he struggles with health challenges including coronary artery disease, high blood pressure, and a spinal fusion in his neck. He also had precancerous lesions that had to be removed from his mouth.

In connection to these lesions, Wilton had to have his teeth and part of his jaw bone removed on both arches, making eating difficult. Unfortunately, Wilton could not afford the dental treatment needed to restore his oral health after undergoing these operations. Getting by on a Social Security benefit and military pension, he struggles to make ends meet, and the treatment he needed seemed out of reach.



This all changed when a team of DDS volunteers stepped in to help. Among these volunteers was Dr. Wayne Harper, a DDS volunteer since 2019. With the help of a volunteer lab, Dr. Harper provided Wilton with full upper and lower dentures. Through the generous volunteers, Wilton received thousands of dollars' worth of donated dental care, restoring his health, his ability to eat, and his smile.
