# Dental Lifeline Network • MONTANA ANNUAL REPORT THE STORY

The Montana Donated Dental Services (DDS) program helps patients like Lucy, 61, a widow who lives alone in Winston. Lucy was diagnosed with a spinal cord tumor in 2010 and has undergone several surgeries to remove the tumor and address issues with her spine and brain. Despite that, she experiences challenges with her balance, poor dexterity, numbness and back and neck pain. Lucy's dental health presented another concern: she had broken and decayed teeth and experienced frequent pain. She sought help at a local dental clinic but was unable to afford the recommended treatment. Before she became disabled, Lucy worked in hayfields as well as in a warehouse. Now she is unable to work and relies on a Social Security Disability benefit that is consumed entirely by her monthly living expenses. Dental treatment seemed far beyond her reach.

### **HOW DDS HELPED**

This all changed when a team of DDS volunteers came to Lucy's aid. Dr. Kathyrn Sealey extracted one tooth and restored 16 others. Next, Dr. Jaden Erwin extracted two more teeth and placed two implants donated by Straumann USA. Finally, Dimensional Dental Design and McTech Dental Lab donated 13 crowns. Thanks to these incredibly generous volunteers, Lucy received thousands of dollars of donated treatment that restored her dental health!
