**WHEREAS**, almost 385 dentists and 130 dental labs volunteer for the Donated Dental Services Program and have collectively treated more than 1,500 people with seriously neglected dental problems throughout Missouri since the program's inception; and

**WHEREAS**, the Missouri Donated Dental Services Program recently surpassed \$5 million in donated dental services through the generosity and benevolence of dentists and laboratories throughout the state of Missouri, and nationally the Donated Dental Services Program has provided \$250 million in donated dental services nationwide; and

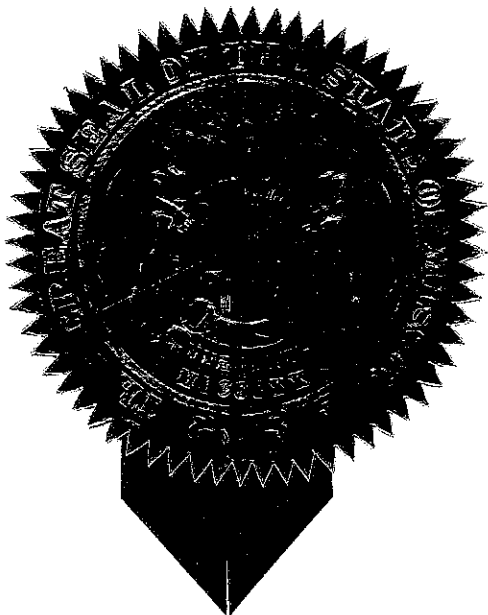

### **DONATED DENTAL SERVICES RECOGNITION DAY**



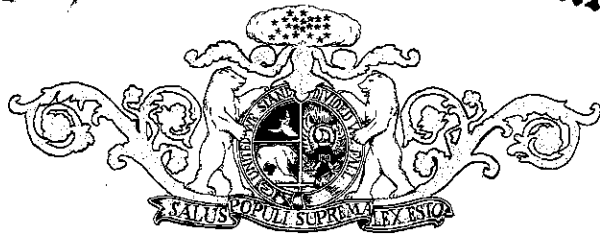

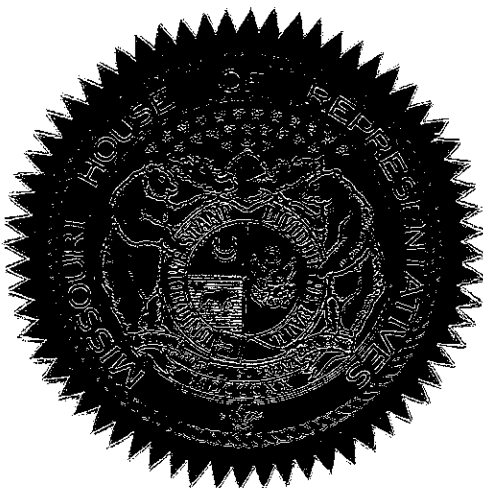
